Mail-house safety



When getting your mail, getting out of the car, stopping or turning around, please pay attention to your surroundings to prevent any accidents. There are many cars coming and going

When you order anything to be delivered to your home, **make sure you include your Lot number with your address for accurate delivery.**

Please do not block the mail-house when picking up your kids from school. Nancy Justema Park away from the entrance for everyone's safety.



What is Chip Seal?

Chip Seal is an effective pavement maintenance treatment that sprays a thin layer of heated liquid asphalt onto an existing road surface, followed by a layer of small crushed stones (chips) that are embedded by rollers. This process provides a waterproof, protective membrane that keeps water from entering the road base, seals the surface, preventing water damage which causes potholes, structural failures and increasing tire traction.
